### Remote Learning

As a result of the government's announcement to 'close' all school due to the continuing Coronavirus pandemic, a great number of children are now learning remotely once again. Since we first started remote learning in March 2020, primary schools have taken great strides to develop their remote learning offer. We have gone from a position of never having had to provide such styles of learning, to now consistently offering a full school day via a digital learning platform.

Over the last week, we have been reviewing our Remote Learning Strategy to ensure that we are offering our children the same high quality education at home that they receive in school whilst also fulfilling the DfE's new expectations. Here is a summary of what our remote learning offer will include:-

Teachers will provide daily marking and feedback of all remote learning completed. Teacher will be available to respond to work between the hours of 8.30am to 4.00pm Monday to Friday.

**Please note that schools are required to provide 3hours of remote learning each day for KS1 children and 4hours each day for KS2 children.**
