World leaders are meeting in Glasgow this November for a crucial meeting about the climate crisis and the future of our planet and its people. We are fundraising to support communities around the world who are protecting the planet.



Earlier this term, the children joined in with CAFOD's on line national school's assembly: 'Go Green'.
