THE QUEEN'S JUBILEE

Her majesty, Queen Elizabeth, has reigned for 70 years, making her the UK's longest reigning monarch! To mark her 70 year-long-reign, children will have the opportunity to participate in a number of fun activities. These will take place on Friday 27th May and are all optional. All of the events taking place are free so you do not need to bring any money to school on this day. The events that are taking place in school are:

Cakes with crowns – To participate in this event, you need to make a Queen themed cake and bring it into school on the morning of the 27th May. This activity is a competition that will be judged by the school council. Cakes will be judged on taste and overall presentation. Certificates will be given to the winning cakes.

We will also be eating cakes in school which the school will provide including cakes for children with allergies. If you have any questions about this, please speak to your class teacher.

Crowns, Kings & Queens – To take part in this event you need to make a crown/royal hat at home being as creative with your designs as possible. You should then bring your creation to school ready for the royal hat parade that will take place in the playground. In each year group, a boy and girl will be selected to be their class King and Queen based on the most creative hat or crown. There will be a small prize for each winner. Please note all crowns or hats entered into this competition need to be homemade. You should not just buy a crown.

Royal family dress up - To participate in this activity, you should dress up in the United Kingdom's main colours – red, white and blue. If you choose to take part in this event, it will be a non-uniform day but you should only wear the three colours mentioned. You are very welcome to wear a royal family headpiece should you wish to.

Her majesty's assembly – There will also be a school assembly marking this special occasion. The assembly will explain about the Queen and her achievements. It will include a video of her coronation, facts about her and a fun quiz.
