| Year 1  | Year 2   |
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| This week, Year 1 began their new topic 'God's great plan'. We read<br>the story of Creation and discussed how the story is found in the<br>Bible. We spoke about all the great things God created for  | We started a new RE topic this week which focusses on beginnings.<br>This week we looked at the creation story. After reading the<br>creation story we discussed what God created on each day and then<br>created a story board of it. When the focussed on the line 'and God<br>was pleased with what he saw' and decided what God would look at<br>in the work and see was very good.  |
| Year 3  | Year 4   |
| This week Year 3 have been thinking about our homes and how they<br>are special places for us to live. They then read the letter from Paul<br>to the Romans which tells Christians what makes a good Christian.<br>The children then thought about all the people who showed those<br>qualities to them.  | This week in RE, Year 4 have begun to look at the topic of The Bible.<br>We have learnt how the bible is organised and how to find chapters<br>and verses in the bible. We enjoyed listening to each other's<br>favourite stories from the bible in a class discussion. The children<br>were keen on being able to find stories and references in the bible<br>with their partner.   |
| Year 5  | Year 6   |
| We started our Creation topic by discussing how we believed that<br>the world began. The children created a diagram explaining the<br>many theories explaining how the word began and the stories in the<br>Bible which talk about Creation. We then reflected on the Creation<br>story and thought about what it teaches us. The children wrote<br>down three questions they would like to ask God about creation and<br>the Creation story. | This week in RE, Year 6 started their new topic 'The Kingdom of God'.<br>To begin with, the children explored their own ideas of what they<br>think the Kingdom of God is and where it might be located. The class<br>looked at some of the values of the Kingdom of God and wrote<br>prayers based on a few chosen values. The second part of the<br>learning this week focused on two parables: The Parable of the<br>Mustard Seed and the Parable of the Yeast. From these, the children<br>further developed their ideas about the Kingdom of God. |
