### **Year 2 Trip to Paxton Pits Nature Reserve**

As part of our Science topic, 'Habitats, Food Chains and Plants', Year 2 will be visiting Paxton Pits Nature Reserve on **Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2024**. The children will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9.00am and returning to school by approx. 3.15pm. Please drop off and pick up your child at the usual time.

Children will take part in a day of activities all based around the theme "Wild Journeys: Habitats through time". Each child would be issued with a time travel explorer kit bag and time travel wristband for the day, to enable them to go on the adventure! Pupils will learn about the history of the nature reserve, discover the amazing birdlife and have the opportunity to do pond dipping to find out what creatures now live at Paxton Pits.

We are asking parents to contribute to the cost; however, should insufficient funds be received then the trip will be unable to go ahead. **The total cost for the trip including coach travel and entry fee is £18.00. This should be paid online, on Wisepay by Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2024.**

Children will need to bring a packed lunch (nut-free) and drink (no cans or glass bottles).

If you would like a Packed Lunch provided by our school kitchen, please indicate on the slip below by Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2024 (these must be pre-ordered).

The venue also recommend that you send your child with a healthy snack to eat during the morning to help sustain them for a very busy day of activities.

Children should wear their own sensible, warm, old clothes and trainers. Please bring wellies or sturdy boots for the trip in a named carrier bag. Due to the nature of the activities, clothes and footwear are likely to get dirty. They should also bring a warm weatherproof coat, hat and gloves as most of the visit will be spent outdoors.
